



Code of Conduct for the Police and Crime Commissioner for Leicestershire

1. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this Code is to set out the standards of behaviour expected of the Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC), any staff employed by the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC Staff), members of the Joint Audit, Risk and Assurance Panel (JARAP) and members of the Ethics, Integrity and Complaints Committee.

The public is entitled to expect the PCC, members of PCC staff, JARAP members and members of the Ethics, Integrity and Complaints Committee to conduct themselves in accordance with the highest standards. Public confidence could be damaged if appropriate standards are not maintained.

2. VALUES AND PRINCIPLES OF CONDUCT

a) Accountability

I will be answerable for my decisions, actions and omissions.

b) Fairness

I will treat people fairly.

c) Honesty

I will be truthful and trustworthy.

d) Integrity

I will always do the right thing Openness.

e) Leadership

I will lead by good example.

f) Objectivity

I will be open and transparent in my actions and decisions.

g) Openness

I will be open and transparent in my actions and decisions.

h) Respect

I will treat everyone with respect.

i) Selflessness

I will act in the public interest.

3. The Commissioner has adopted this code and has agreed to abide by its provisions.



Application of the Policing Principles of Public Life

In abiding with these principles, I agree to do so in conjunction with the following:

- All applicable statute and prevailing laws within the United Kingdom.
- The standing financial instructions and contract standing orders applicable to the Office of Police and Crime Commissioner for Leicestershire.
- The advice provided by the Monitoring Officer and Chief Financial Officer, (or deputies of either of these statutory postholders) of the Office of Police and Crime Commissioner for Leicestershire.
- The Financial Management Code of Practice for the Police Service of England and Wales.
- The Policing Protocol Order 2011 (and any subsequent statutory amendments)
- Disclosure of all pecuniary interests.

This code is applicable in all circumstances where the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner for Leicestershire might be brought into disrepute.
