Your request for information has now been considered and the response can be found below:

The Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner (OPCC) does receive Home Office DA perpetrator funding, however the OPCC does not hold the information that you have requested.

The DA perpetrator funding is commissioned to FreeVa, who have confirmed that they do not have an Executive Summary/Evaluation of this programme.

The Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner provides you the right to ask for a re-examination of your request under its review procedure.
