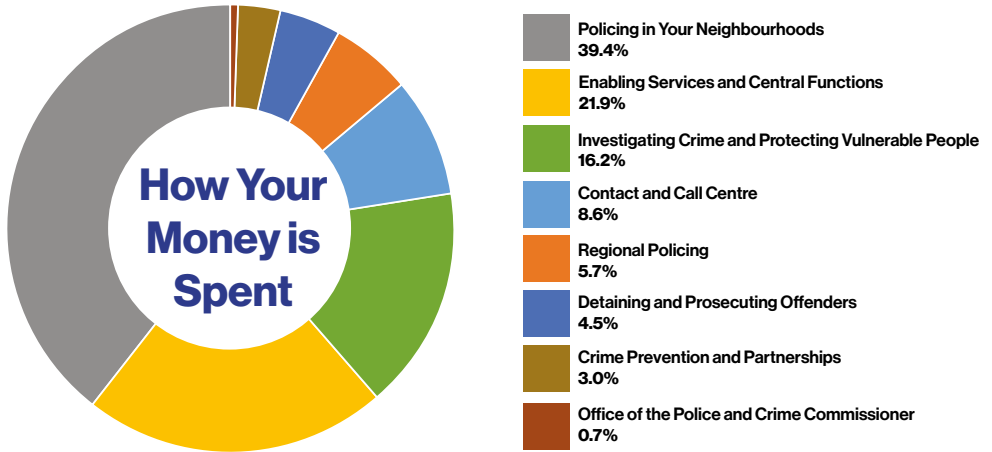

# MONEY MATTERS

The budget for 2025-26 has been set at **£255m** which is an increase of **£11.6m (4.8%)** from **2024-25**.

Funding for policing comes from a combination of Central Government, Council Tax and grant income. For **2025-26** the Government provides **56%** of the budget figure and **44%** comes from local taxpayers. This means the amount of council tax a **Band D** property will pay towards policing will increase by **27p** per week.
