




## **MONEY MATTERS**

The budget for 2025-26 has been set at £255m which is an increase of £11.6m (4.8%) from 2024-25.

Funding for policing comes from a combination of Central Government. Council Tax and grant income. For 2025-26 the Government provides 56% of the budget figure and 44% comes from local taxpayers. This means the amount of council tax a **Band D** property will pay towards policing will increase by 27p per week.
