Title: Award of contract for Integrated Communications Control System (ICCS)

### Summary of Issue:

The Emergency Services Network (ESN) is a Home Office mandated programme for the replacement of Airwave with the next generation integrated critical voice and broadband data services for the 3 emergency services.

Integrated Communications Control System (ICCS) systems are an essential component to the smooth running of Police Control Rooms, freeing Contact Management staff from the complexity of managing communications so that they concentrate on responding to the public. ICCS systems will have to be updated to allow Control Room colleagues to communicate on both Airwave and ESN,

Leicestershire Police's DS3000 ICCS is provided and supported by Capita. The DS3000 will require a significant upgrade to become ESN Ready. The upgrade will be performed in two stages, with the bulk of the effort performed early to simplify and reduce the complexity of the ESN transition.

There are expected to be capital costs incurred and an uplift in revenue charges associated with the deployment of an ESN Ready service.

#### Capital:

- Hardware refresh to support the additional requirements of delivering ESN.
- ESN development costs
- Additional licences for ESN features

#### Revenue:

- Changes to ongoing support for ESN.
- Uplift in service to cater for increased security management required for ESN.

As proprietary owners of the DS3000 technology, Capita are the only company that can undertake this work within Leicestershire.
