Title: The Hampton Trust- CARA contract 2021/22

Summary of Issue:

The Police and Crime Commissioner holds a contract with The Hampton Trust. The Hampton Trust provide an out of court disposal programme for perpetrators of domestic abuse, known as CARA. Leicestershire Police refer eligible perpetrators of domestic abuse i.e. those issued an out of court disposal to the programme.

Historically, referrals to the service have been low; a number of factors more recently have influenced demand and these were discussed in detail in the meeting. Currently we are now in a position whereby the number of referrals has exceeded that covered by the contract value and a overspend has developed.

In order to correct this position a plan to split the overspend £ £9,750 between the three parties involved (Leicestershire Police, The Hampton Trust and the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner) has been proposed.

Recommendations presented:

The OPCC to agree pay their share of the overspend to The Hampton Trust, this equates to a single one-off payment of £3,250.
